The week starts with a half day of instruction on the water. You'll learn the fundamentals of saltwater casting, wading, spotting fish, and working with a guide. The rest of the trip you fish with a guide while the host rotates among the group to help where necessary. Each student will receive a brand new 8-weight Orvis rod, reel and line to take home with him or her. Leaders, tippet and flies will also be included in your price. All you need to bring with you is clothing for a warm, sunny climate, and a positive attitude.

Learn saltwater fly-fishing in a beautiful location with lots of bonefish. Hosted by an Orvis host and saltwater expert, this is a hands-on field seminar that packs a lifetime of experience into five days. You'll spend most of your time on the water, wading or casting from a boat, while the Orvis host or your guide coaches you.

The trip starts on Sunday with a welcome reception and ends on

Saturday morning with breakfast and a transfer to the airport. You can extend and fish with a guide on Saturday if you want to round out the week. Each session is limited to 8 anglers per week so you're assured of personal attention.



The Lodge

The location couldn't be better: an upscale lodge in a remote, forested area, on one of the world's premier bonefishing islands. Their strategic location allows you to fish a multitude of hard sand flats, with good protection from the wind, should it decide to blow. Tiamo is a wonderful choice if you're looking for an intimate

tropical resort that appeals to both the saltwater fly fisher and a non-fishing companion.

		Depart with guides for the flats. Two anglers go with a guide in a flats boat and stay out the whole day. The instructor will rotate among the group to provide additional assistance. At first, you may need advice about working as a team with the guide, spotting fish, and fly selection. You stay out all day and there's a good mix of wading and fishing from the skiff.

- TBA Transfers to Congo Town Airport for flights home or extend your stay. (Please let us know well in advance.)
- **Equipment:** The basic equipment is included (shipped to you before the trip) and the host will supply you with bonefish leaders and one dozen flies. You need to bring appropriate clothes and flats wading shoes. We'll supply you with a packing list.

Getting there: Most guests fly to Nassau and take the local commuter flight to Congo Town. If you choose this option, you should plan on arriving in Nassau by 1:30 PM to make the connection. If you would like, Orvis Travel can reserve your seats on the flight from Nassau to Congo Town for a \$25 per ticket convenience charge. You will pay \$140 per person cash when you check in for the flight. A good option, if your schedule will allow, is to fly through Fort Lauderdale and take the Lynx Air flight direct to Congo Town. This flight runs on Wednesdays, Saturdays and Sundays and should be booked directly

with Lynx Air. Private charters from Nassau and Ft. Lauderdale are also available. Regardless of the option you choose, a representative of Tiamo will meet you upon your

Reservations, Deposits & Payments

The deposit is 25% of the trip price unless stated differently in the itinerary. Deposits may be made by check or credit card: Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Discover Card.

The balance of the trip cost is due 90 days before departure, except where specified differently on individual itineraries.

A signed reservation form and release are required prior to departure.

All prices must be paid in U.S. dollars.

Deposits are not transferable from one trip to another. Prices quoted are based on foreign exchange values and tariffs currently in effect and prices are subject to change. Orvis Travel reserves the right to adjust prices

accordingly until the time of departure.

Planning information

When your reservation is confirmed, you will receive planning information to guide you through trip preparations.
